For most of us, our vote is the only way we can influence government: we're busy with work and family and we often can't afford to donate to candidates (and even if we can, we can't compete with wealthy donors, PACs, Super PACS, and party committees).

But our election system makes it harder than it should be to register to vote and cast a ballot. It's worse for lower-income voters and young people, who move more often or work irregular hours, making it harder to get to registrars before deadlines or to the polls on Election Day. In addition, too many districts use obsolete electronic voting systems, vulnerable to hacking, that in some cases provide no paper trail for verifying the vote.
